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This is a provincially sanctioned schooling show under the rules of Equine Canada.

CLASSES

CLASSES 1(a) and 1(b) WELCOME TO NEWCOMERS – for riders who have never been in a dressage ring before 2015. You may enter these classes at all shows, green or more experienced horses may be used. 20 x 40m ring

CLASS 1(a): CADORA Walk/Trot Test A.

CLASS 1(b): Dressage Canada 2009 Walk/Trot Test A

CLASSES 2(a) and 2(b): INTRODUCTORY DRESSAGE – for horses in their first or second year of dressage competition only, including events and schooling shows. Green or more experienced riders may enter. 20 x 40m ring.

CLASS 2(a): CADORA Walk/Trot Test C.

CLASS 2(b): Dressage Canada 2010 Walk/Trot Test B

CLASS 3 DRESSAGE EQUITATION – Walk/Trot – Riders in this class may not enter any canter classes.

CLASS 4 DRESSAGE EQUITATION – Walk/Trot/Canter – Riders to be judged at walk, trot and canter, not more than six to a group.

CLASS 5 2015 USEF Training Level Test 1, 20 x 40m or 20 x 60m

CLASS 6 2015 USEF Training Level Test 2, 20 x 40m or 20 x 60m

CLASS 7 2015 USEF First Level Test 1, 20 x 60m

CLASS 8 2015 USEF First Level Test 2, 20 x 60m

You may enter 2 consecutive levels, a maximum of 4 technical tests plus equitation. All Equine Canada tests are available on the DRESSAGE CANADA web site www.dressagecanada.org. CADORA tests are available at www.CADORA.ca.

CLASS 9: FREESTYLE TO MUSIC – You may ride Freestyles: Solo, Pas de Deux or Quadrille. EC first Level Freestyle; CADORA Freestyles; Novice (W/T) Freestyles. Please specify test and arena size on Entry Form.

CLASS 10: SPECIAL REQUESTS: Any current OADG, EC (Training and First Levels only), CADORA, or Canadian Eventing Test or a breed-specific test. You can use these shows to practice for a forthcoming competition, to try upgrading, or for your experience. **Please specify tests and arena size on Entry Form.**

ENTRIES

\$25.00 PER CLASS, HST included. Admin Fee \$10. Classes 1(a), 1(b), 2(a) and 2(b) are separate classes. All competitors must be members of the Ontario Equestrian Federation (OEF) or other Provincial Equestrian Organization.

Membership forms are available online at <http://horse.on.ca/> or the show secretary at the show.

Entries must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by 7pm, Monday before the show, and must include a current negative Coggins Test and a photocopy of the OEF membership.

A limited amount of stabling is available \$50 per stall. To reserve a stall please call the show secretary. Refreshments will be available on the showgrounds.

Directions to Oakhurst: Hwy 7: 10km east of Carleton Place, take Dwyer Hill Road South. 2km turn left on Fernbank Road. 0.5km to show site at 8249 Fernbank Road.

Late entries will be accepted if there is room. Phone, and email entries will be accepted with a visa or mastercard number. Email transfers are also accepted. A status list of entries will be posted on the Oakhurst website www.oakhurstfarm.com

RIDING TIMES will be posted on the Oakhurst website on the Thursday before the show.

Tack to be in accordance with EC rules. Horses may wear boots and/or bandages; whips may be carried. Riding dress may be informal. Ponies welcome.

REFUNDS: If an entry is withdrawn before the closing date, a \$10.00 handling fee will be retained. After the closing date there will be no refunds unless your times are filled by someone on the waiting list.

PRIZES

Ribbons to 5th place. Prizes from Sponsors.

If entries warrant, classes will be divided Open/Junior/Adult Amateur/Peewee.

OADG YEAR END AWARDS: Scores from classes 1-9 are eligible for related year-end OADG Local Schooling show awards to be given out at the OADG Banquet in November. Scores are counted equally regardless of ring size (either 20 x 40m or 20 x 60m). Trophies and plaques will be awarded for the following categories. W/T Horse (JR, AA,O), W/T Rider (JR,AA), Equitation (W/T, W/T/C), Training (JR,AA,O), First (JR,AA,O). Musical Combination and a single overall award sponsored by Horse World for the top Schooling Show horse/rider (excluding scores from Equitation and Musical Combination classes). Scores from classes 1,2,5,6,7 and 8 are also eligible for OADG Schooling Show Merit awards for scores over 60%. Riders (and at least one owner of the horse if different from the rider) must be members of the OADG on the competition date for scores to count towards OADG year-end awards. Scores for OADG awards can be earned at any local Schooling Show.

ADULT AMATEUR DIVISION: AA division is open to Senior Riders who do not teach riders or train horses for remuneration, do not act as an agent for the purchase/sale/lease of horses, do not give clinics or seminars for remuneration, are not Juniors, are not CET Short or Long Listed riders, are not current or former CET members, and have not represented Canada Internationally. Please see Equine Canada, Section E Dressage, Rule 3.4.2 Amateur for a full list of those NOT considered Amateurs for Dressage Competition.

JUNIOR DIVISION: Is open to all competitors who have not reached their 18th birthday as of 1 January, 2017.

PEEWEE DIVISION: Is open to all juniors who have not reached their 11th birthday as of 1 January, 2017. PeeWees are eligible for the OADG year-end single overall PeeWee Award. They (and the owner of the horse, if different) do NOT have to be OADG members. Forms are required to be sent in to the OADG awards director to be eligible for the award (because we do not know who you are without a form). Note that PeeWees are also considered JR's and are eligible for JR OADG awards provided they are OADG members as indicated in the previous paragraph.)

CLASS 10 'SPECIAL REQUEST' scores cannot be used for any show-day championships or year-end awards. For full information about all OADG awards for the Ontario ESD Schooling Show Circuit, please visit the OADG website at www.ottawadressage.ca
